Re: Revised IFEX Contract Specifications and Listing of December 2010 Contracts

CCFE has revised the "New Contract Listing" definition for all of its IFEX futures products. The date for listing the annual December contract months will be the first business day after November 30th, which is widely recognized as the end of the hurricane season. (The old definition called for the next annual December contract month to be listed on the first business day of a new calendar year.)

In adherence to the New Contract Listing definition, the December 2010 contract month will be listed for trading on Friday, December 12, 2008.

The IFEX futures products include the ELF U.S. Tropical Wind Events, ELF Florida Tropical Wind Events and the ELF Gulf Coast Tropical Wind Events.
