Re: PCS Catastrophe Bulletin on Hurricane Ike – Re-Survey Estimate

PCS has issued another catastrophe bulletin with re-survey estimated insured property damages associated with Hurricane Ike. CCFE is providing a summary of the bulletin’s information as it relates to CCFE IFEX Tropical Wind Events products.¹

In accordance with CCFE rules, when PCS publishes a final estimate on insured property damages associated with a “Storm Family”, CCFE will determine whether a Covered Event has occurred at a specific Loss Trigger Level and will communicate with the market place accordingly. Market participants should refer to the CCFE Rulebook for the rules relating to the settlement and delisting of IFEX Tropical Wind Event products.
