Re: Change to Deliverable Instruments for REC NJ Aug Futures Contracts

CCFE has revised the “Deliverable Instruments” definition for its REC NJ August futures contracts. **This revision does not affect any contract containing open interest, and is effective as of August 14, 2009.**

Previously, for REC NJ August contracts, RECs acceptable for delivery were those having been generated between June 1st and December 1st of the calendar year of the expiring contract. Effective August 14, 2009, for REC NJ August contracts, RECs acceptable for delivery are those having been generated between June 1st of the year prior to the contract expiration and May 31st of the calendar year of the expiring contract.

This new specification takes into account the change in the compliance filing deadline from September 1 to October 1 made by the NJ Board of Public Utilities. Furthermore, the rules and contract specifications for the REC NJ contract have been revised to clarify that RECs eligible for delivery are Class I RECs or solar RECs, each as described in the New Jersey Administrative Code (see the link above, subchapter 14:8-2.2).
