Re: Required Port Changes for Connecting to the CCFE and CCX Trading Platform

CCFE and CCX Platform users connecting via the Internet are required to make the port changes detailed below by Monday, September 14, 2009 in order to access the CCFE and CCX Platforms.

To facilitate users with this transition, CCX and CCFE Helpdesk representatives will contact traders not connecting properly over the next two weeks.

The Exchange is rolling out data distribution for individual market groups (currently served exclusively over ports 80/443) into a dynamic range of ports between 10000 and 10999. Segregating the various data streams will allow the Exchanges to optimize server- and client-side components to handle specific requests based on individual subscription.

All CCX and CCFE Trading Platform users must connect to the new ports. Legacy connections over ports 80/443 will be permanently disconnected on Monday, September 14, 2009.

- FIX Order Routing
- FIX Trade Capture
